- 2008 will be in Copenhagen hosted by TimeVision 



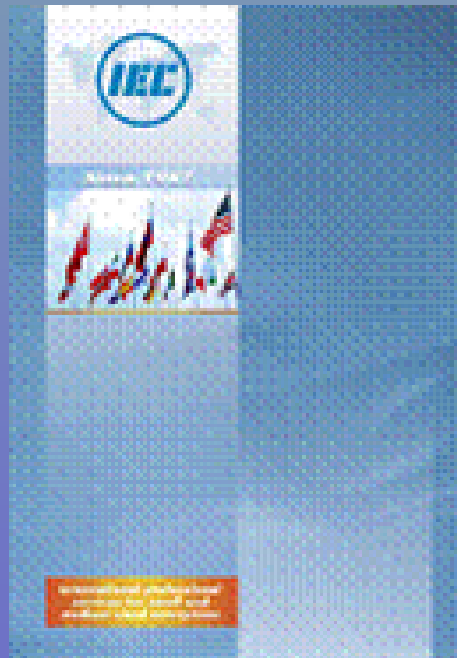
IEC also offers:

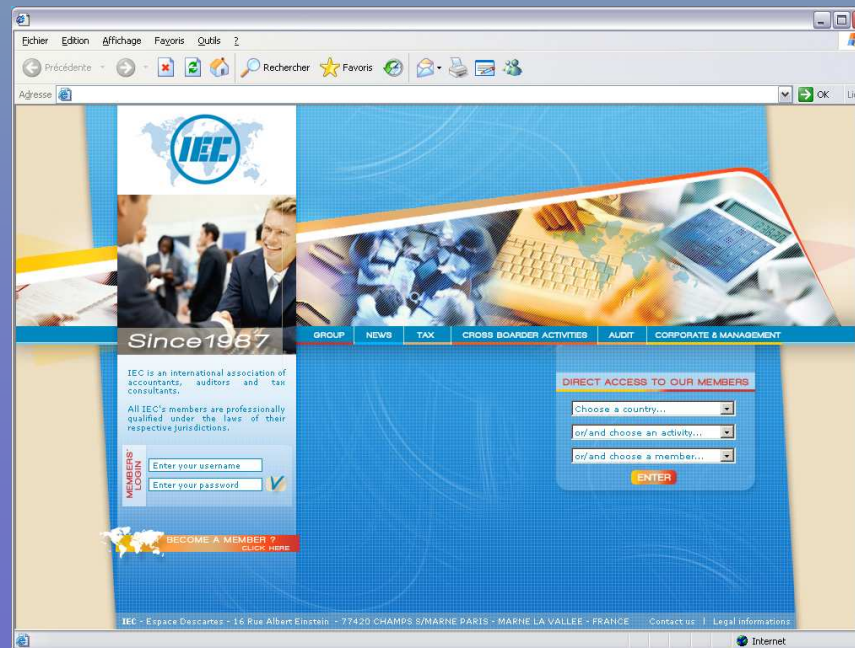
IEC provides a brochure

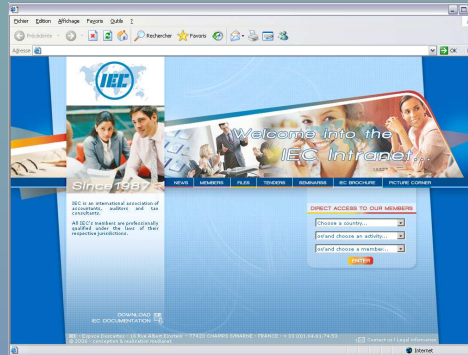
IEC website
